BASELINE was retained by Yolo County to prepare an Initial Study and EIR for an expanded mining operation at the existing Schwarzgruber mining site.



The Initial Study was completed in accordance with an accelerated schedule and identified potentially significant impacts related to aesthetics, biological resources, and noise. These issues were analyzed in a Focused EIR.

The EIR analysis identified potentially significant impacts related aesthetics, noise from intensified mining operations, water quality impacts related to mining within the FEMA 100-year flood hazard zone, and biological impacts. BASELINE provided all deliverables on time and within budget. The EIR was certified and the project approved by the Yolo County Board of Supervisors in November 2012.
